

Bishop John Martindale Speechly (13 November 1836 - 22 January 1898)



John Martindale Speechly, the first Bishop of Travancore and Cochin, was a tireless steward in the Lord's vineyard. Born on 13 November 1836 in Whittlesey, Cambridgeshire, Speechly was educated at St John's College, Cambridge, and ordained in 1860. In 1862 he reached India as a missionary of Church Missionary Society and was stationed at Kunnamkulam until 1863 when he became the Principal of the Cambridge Nicholson Institute at Kottayam. He was consecrated as bishop in 1879. His tenure as the Bishop of the Diocese of Central Travancore witnessed rapid spiritual growth in this part of the country. The number of parishes increased by leaps and bounds within a short span of time. The devastating floods of 1882 brought out the best in the Bishop. With indomitable will and unflinching faith, the benevolent Bishop provided the much-needed healing touch to many in distress. He returned to England and died on 22 January 1898. He is buried at Whittlesey Cemetery. Generations remember him for his service to humanity. Bishop Speechly College for Advanced Studies and Bishop Speechly Vidyapeet, on the Buchanan Campus, Pallom, stand as memorial to this noble shepherd who tended the sheep under his care with a rare warmth of love.


